Everton Women will be entering into an exciting new collaboration with Liverpool Feds Women's Football Club.

The agreement will see the Feds play their home fixtures at Walton Hall Park – underlining Everton's ongoing commitment to supporting the growth of the girls' and women's football pyramid.

The move will see Liverpool Feds benefit from WSL facilities, an elite level pitch and enhanced player and supporter amenities as the club competes against Burnley, Wolves, Stoke and West Brom in a competitive division.

Walton Hall Park, alongside Everton Under-21s men's team who will play their home fixtures there, ensuring the stadium plays a central role in supporting development football across the city. Welcoming the Feds to the stadium is another powerful step

Founded in 1990, Liverpool Feds have developed from a grassroots side into one of the region's leading women's football clubs. They now compete in the FA Women's National League Northern Premier Division, the third tier of women's football in England.
