ASHTON LADIES

Formed in 2022 as an u15s girls team, the squad became Champions of Europe the following summer winning the Barcelona Girls Cup, beating Norway's IA Akraness.

They joined the inaugural North West Girls Super League in 2023, lifting the u16s title unbeaten. In 2024/25, the team made its open-age debut in the Liverpool Women's League and went on to make history that season by winning an historic treble of the league title, league cup and Liverpool County Cup at Walton Hall Park.
