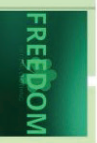

LEANNE DUFFY

WELCOME

BURNLEY

Burnley Football Club's women's team was initially established as Burnley FC Girls and Ladies in 1995.

Originally playing in the Lancashire League, the team later moved to the North West Women's Regional League.

At the end of the 2016/17 season, the management and operation of the team was transferred to the Club's charitable arm, Burnley FC in the Community.

The transition paid off immediately as, in 2017/18, Burnley won three preliminary round fixtures against Fleetwood Town, Merseyrail Bootle and Wigan Athletic to qualify for the FA Cup 1st round proper for the first time in their history.

Promotion to the FA Women's National League Division One North followed, as did a name change to Burnley Women.

The team's growth continued into 2018/19, with Matt Bee's side securing back-to-back promotions to the Northern Premier Division.

After consolidation in the third tier and several seasons impacted by COVID-19, new Burnley Chairman Alan Pace announced in February 2021 that the team would be integrated into the running of the Club.

That summer saw the Clarets become the first team to live stream matches on TikTok and, in April 2023, the team took to the Turf Moor pitch for the first time ever in a 2-1 victory over Liverpool Feds.



LAST SEASON RESULT

8TH - 24/25



Under Head Coach Rebecca Sawiuk the team earned its highest ever third-tier finish of 2nd in 2023/24. The squad then had a refresh over the summer with 12 players joining from Championship level or above.

Louise Roberts was named manager on an interim basis in March 2025 and her second match in charge saw the Clarets win the Lancashire FA Senior Cup for a third year running, thanks to a 4-1 victory over Chorley. This summer saw the women's team take the next big step in its journey, transitioning to a full-time, professional model.

Former Women's Super League winning manager Matt Beard was named manager in June 2025, bringing a wealth of experience from his time in charge of Liverpool.

There were a plethora of additions to the playing squad too and the Club has enjoyed an impressive start to the campaign.

In February 2026, former Claret Ross Wallace took interim charge for the remainder of the season.

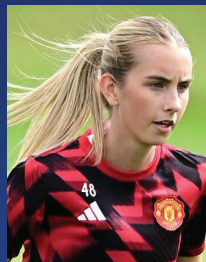
