SPORTING KHALSA

Sporting Khalsa Women and Girls compete in the FA Women's National League Northern Division. The club was formed in 2015 following a merger with FC Reedswood, founded in 2004, and the women's section continues to be overseen by chairwoman and founder Kelly Williams.

The club operates a strong development pathway, with a thriving girls' section, two senior sides, a Wildcats Centre for girls aged 5-11, and a SQUAD programme for players aged 12-14.

In their 20th anniversary year, Sporting Khalsa secured promotion and won the Staffordshire

Women's County Cup, earning a place in Tier 3 for the first time.

The 2024/25 season saw the Queens finish 10th, comfortably clear of relegation and just one point off seventh, while also reaching another County Cup final.

Following the departure of long-serving manager Andy Mulligan, former first-team coach Juan Dupazo was appointed manager ahead of the current season.

Home matches are played on Sunday afternoons at the Guardian Warehousing Arena.
