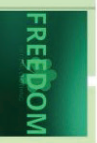

RUGBY BOROUGH

Rugby Borough Women's FC were originally founded in 2013 as Coventry City Ladies. The club merged with Coventry United Men's to form Coventry United Ladies Football Club in 2015.

Last season, Rugby Borough Women FC finished third in the FA Women's National League. They also earned their first trophy under their new name, beating Wolverhampton Wanderers in the Birmingham FA Challenge Cup.

April 2019 saw the side win the FA National League South, gaining promotion to the FA Women's Championship.

Due to the geographic location of the club, Rugby Borough Women FC now play in the Northern Region of the FA Women's National League.

In June 2023, following the club's relegation from the Women's Championship, the club renamed as Rugby Borough Women FC and changed home grounds to Kilsby Lane, Rugby. The club now runs a hybrid training model, with the aim of being promoted back into the Championship and returning to being full-time.
